	DATE/TIME						
Face							
0 - No particular expression							
1 - Occasional grimace, withdrawn, disinterested							
2 - Frequent grimace, clenched jaw							
Legs							
0 - Normal position or relaxed							
1 - Uneasy, restless, tense							
2 - Kicking, or legs drawn up							
Activity							
0 - Lying quietly, normal position, moves easily							
1 - Squirming, shifting back and forth, tense							
2 - Arched, rigid or jerking							
Cry							
0 - No cry, whine(awake or asleep)							
1 - Moans or whimpers; occasional yipe							
2 - Crying steadily, screams, frequent yipes							
Consolability/Stress							
0 - Content, relaxed							
1 - Reassured by occasional touching, hugging or being talked to, distractible							
2 - Difficult to console or comfort							
TOTAL SCORE							
RAMSAY SEDATION SCALE							
1 - Patient anxious, agitated, restless							
2 - Patient cooperative, oriented, tranquil							
3 - Patient responds to commands only							
4 - Brisk response to light gabellar tap or auditory stimulus							
5 - Sluggish response to light gabellar tap or auditory stimulus							
6 - No response to the stimulus mentioned in items 4 and 5
